Approving temporary construction work with associated noise impacts between the hours of 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM on Service Road / Frontage Road (W. Beltline Hwy.). (4th AD)

Body

PREAMBLE

The sanitary sewer is scheduled to be re-lined on the following street:

Service Rd / Frontage Rd. (W. Beltline Hwy.) Starting at the southeast corner of Grandview Blvd. and ending at the intersection of Todd Dr. and Service Rd.

This process will extend the life of the sanitary sewer pipe and extend the time until the pipe needs to be removed and replaced. The lining of the sewer pipe is proposed to be completed at night when flows in the pipe are lower and traffic is lighter.

Construction activities generally exceed the noise limits imposed by the Madison General Ordinances and temporary construction activity between the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM is allowed to exceed the noise limits imposed by the Madison General Ordinances. Madison General Ordinance section 24.08(3) provides the Common Council the ability to allow construction activities, with associated noise impacts, outside of the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. with the passage of a resolution.
