**Fiscal Note**

In the adopted 2017 capital budget Engineering Major Streets has budgeted \$10 million for the repavement of substandard roadways via the Pavement Management capital program (MUNIS 10540). The minor project for the 2017 resurfacing projects is established with sufficient budget authority for the cost of the proposed contract. The resolution awards the contract at an estimated cost of \$1,821,410.
