Body

WHEREAS, the Madison Department of Public Health has conducted a Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) since 1981; and

WHEREAS, the WIC Program is highly effective in improving the health and nutritional status of women (pregnant, breastfeeding, and post-partum), infants, and children who are eligible for the Program based on income and health risk factors;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Madison Department of Public Health is authorized to accept up to \$474,800 to be used for wages, benefits, and non-personnel expenses of the WIC Program and the Mayor and City Clerk

are authorized to sign a contract on behalf of the City.
