**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution authorizes an amendment to the existing contract for engineering services for the total amount of \$36,804.00. The new contract as amended will total \$255,031.53.

The City of Madison Engineering Division is proposing to conduct watershed and flood studies for the west and near west sides as a result of extreme rain events over the past several years. The City entered into an agreement with Brown and Caldwell for engineering services (RES-19-00205). The City Engineer requested additional engineering services and recommend that they be undertaken by Brown and Caldwell for the Stricker's/Mendota Watershed Study as defined below:
