**Fiscal Note**

In the adopted 2016 Capital Budget the Parks Division has budgeted \$75,000 for Goodman Rink Improvements (MUNIS 17434-51-130). This project provides funding for improvements to Goodman Rink. This project has a balance of \$75,000; the estimated cost is \$34,765. Should the resolution be approved the remaining balance would be \$40,235.
