**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution awards the contract for the construction project of Chamberlain Avenue, Van Hise and Mason Street at a total estimated cost of \$1,786,700. Funding for this project is budgeted in the Engineering Major Streets capital budget via the Reconstruction Streets capital program. Funding is provided by GO Borrowing and associated utility components broken out as follows:

- Major Streets - \$845,340
- Stormwater Utility - \$40,260
- Sewer Utility - \$780,160
- Water Utility - \$120,940
