Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plans and authorizes bids for the Wingra Park Shoreline project. The total project cost is estimated to be \$281,880 which will be funded by the Stormwater Utility and Parks Department. The adopted capital budget for the Stormwater Utility will provide \$193,320 of GO Borrowing which is planned within the Stormwater Quality System Improvements program (MUNIS 11562). The Parks Division’s adopted 2018 Capital Budget will provide \$88,560 of Impact Fee funding for this project via the Beach and Shoreline Improvement program (MUNIS 17199).

BE IT RESOLVED,
