Fiscal Note

As stated in the Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and Norman D. Davis, the Civil Rights Director salary will be based on a total annualized rate of \$139,500 effective August 29, 2021. The Civil Rights Director position is approved and funded in the 2021 Adopted Operating Budget. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Mayor's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.
