Fiscal Note

This Ordinance (in conjunction with several others) makes permanent the metered parking on the Capital Square, following the 180-day trial period. All costs and revenues are recognized in the Parking Utility operating budget.

Title

Amending Subsection (290) of Section 12.132 entitled Parking Prohibited At All Times of the Madison General Ordinances (portion of Pinckney Street).

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance revises the Parking Prohibited At All Times on a portion of Pinckney Street.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subsection (290) of Section 12.132 entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"(290) On the east side of Pinckney Street from Mifflin Street East Washington Avenue to Main Street, and on the west side from Dayton Street to Mifflin Street and Main Street to Doty Street, and on both sides from Wilson Street to its south end."
