NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for 2008 Parking Ramp Maintenance at the Overture Center, State Street Capitol, and State Street Campus (Frances) Parking Ramps, be and are hereby approved.
- 2) That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said

project.

- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to accept dedication of lands and/or easements from the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
