## **Body**

**PREAMBLE** 

The roadways within the City of Madison's infrastructure are a considerable investment. Proper maintenance of pavements helps extend the useful life of a pavement. Pavements left in disrepair deteriorate and require resurfacing sooner than pavements, which have preventative maintenance.

Chip Sealing extends the pavements useful life. Chip Sealing helps keep the underlying base dry providing better support for vehicle loading.
