Title

Amending Section 33.29(4) of the Madison General Ordinances to remove specific term limitations on chairperson of Room Tax Commission.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This amendment removes the restriction that a chairperson of the Room Tax Commission may not serve as the Chair for more than three (3) years in any five (5) year period.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

1. Subsection (4) entitled "Powers and Duties" of Section 33.29 entitled "Room Tax Commission is hereby amended as follows:

(4) Powers and Duties. The Room Tax Commission shall have the powers and duties prescribed by Wis. Stat. § 66.0615. Any contract entered into by the Commission shall be approved by the Common Council. The Commission shall elect from among its members a chairperson, vice chairperson and secretary. No person may serve as Chair more than three (3) years in any five (5) year period.
