**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution authorizes the award of Public Works Contract No. 7843, Ronald Regan Avenue, John Wall Drive and Merchant Street Assessment District - 2017. The total estimated cost of the project is \$3,037,640 and is funded by Engineering - Major Streets (\$1,217,400), the Sewer Utility (\$495,890), the Stormwater Utility (\$653,600) and the Water Utility (\$670,750). Funding is available in this project (Munis 11461) for the contract. Additional funding may be necessary to fund the Stormwater contingency depending on change orders.
