Fiscal Note

The estimated additional cost in 2005 is \$9,129 (\$6,700 salary; \$2,429 benefits). Funding is available in the Mayor's Office's 2005 Operating Budget.

Title

Amending the permanent salary detail of the Mayor's Office's 2005 Operating budget.

Body

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Office currently has authorization for three Assistant to the Mayor 1 positions, one Assistant to the Mayor 2 position, and one Legislative Analyst position; and

WHEREAS, there will be a vacancy in a Mayoral Assistant 1 position in the Mayor's Office as of August 22, 2005; and WHEREAS, there is a need to fill this vacancy with a candidate who brings a high level of experience with and knowledge of city government that cannot be accommodated by an Assistant to the Mayor 1 classification; and

WHEREAS, there is adequate funding available in the Mayor's Office's 2005 operating budget to meet targeted salary savings and still cover the increased costs of an Assistant to the Mayor 2 position;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that one Assistant to the Mayor 1 position be deleted from and one Assistant to the Mayor 2 position be added to the 2005 Operating Budget.
