**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution approves plan documents for the Water main replacement coinciding with the Phase 6 of the Cannonball Path near Arbor Hills. The Water Utility has \$411,000 of available budget authority from an adopted 2015 capital project for the proposed work in the Arbor Hills Water Supply project (MUNIS #10435). The estimated cost of the project is \$410,000. Funding is provided by Water Utility Revenue Bonds.
