Fiscal Note

The various provisions of this agreement will result in annual wage and benefit cost increases estimated to total approximately \$40,000, including \$30,000 of increased health insurance premiums, for Police Department commissioned supervisory personnel beginning in 2010. The agreement provides for no general cost of living increase until a 3% wage increase is initiated at the end of the two year term. Sufficient funds have been included in the 2010 Executive Budget to fund the health insurance premium cost increase. The remaining 2010 costs will be absorbed through the reallocation of available budget resources and subsequent operating budgets will include future year costs.
