#### **\*2/3 vote required for confirmation of non-city residents.**

Pursuant to Sec. 3.27(2) of the Madison General Ordinances, " ... provisions of this section shall not necessarily apply with reference to membership on special study committees where in the judgement of the mayor and two-thirds (2/3) of the Common Council, the best interests of the city will be served by the appointment of certain nonresident members who are particularly well qualified by reasons of education, background, and experience ... ."

\*NOE ARTEAGA, 5742 Williamsburg Way, Fitchburg, 53719 - Mr. Arteaga is the manager at Mundo Latino Madison. He has been involved with businesses in the Park Street area and Villager Mall for several years.

Rationale for appointment: Noe Areago owns the Mundo Latino retail store in the Villager Mall along with his wife, Evelyn. He fills one of the three Villager tenant seats on the committee and is the only representative from a private, for-profit business. Mundo Latino has been a tenant at the Villager since December of 1997, and was one of the first Hispanic businesses to locate in the area.
