Title

Amending Section 10.085(3)(a)3. of the Madison General Ordinances to permit LED lighting or other new lighting technology that meet or exceed current lighting standards.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance permits LED lighting or other new lighting technology that meet or exceed current lighting standards.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Paragraph 3. of Subdivision (a) of Subsection (3) entitled "General Requirements" of Section 10.085 entitled "Outdoor Lighting" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"3. Any outdoor lighting fixture installed on a parking lot, parking structure or outdoor merchandizing area shall use either high-pressure sodium, metal halide, ~~or~~ fluorescent lamps, or any other lamps that produce thirty (30) or more lumens per watt. The lighting system shall be extinguished or reduced to fifty percent (50%) no later than thirty (30) minutes after the close of business for the day or after the end of normal office hours for the majority of employees."
