Title

Approving Plans and Specifications for Mineral Point Road at Owen Drive Intersection Improvement. (11th AD)

Body

PREAMBLE

The City of Madison has received federal funds to construct a median pedestrian refuge island at the intersection of Mineral Point Road and Owen Drive. The project has been approved for federal funding covering 100% of the cost of design and construction. The City is eligible for reimbursement up to the maximum cap of \$145,325.

BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for Mineral Point Road at Owen Drive Intersection Improvement be and are hereby approved
- 2) That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to accept dedication of lands and/or easements from the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways
