NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council authorizes the Office of Community Services to accept the funds from the Kiwanis Club, placing them in a segregated account for use in the early childhood education campaign; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City thanks the members of the club for their concern for the future of the children of the City of Madison, and congratulates them on their dedication and perseverance in supporting this goal; and
