**PREAMBLE** 

The project consist of removing the existing non-doweled concrete pavement in the bus lane and bike lane on University Avenue from Park Street to Charter Street and replacing it with doweled concrete pavement.

Certain construction operations may require work during the evening hours. City Engineering will separately initiate a public notification to allow the contractor to work between the hours of 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM.

### BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for University Avenue Pavement Repairs 2006, be and are hereby approved.
- That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project.
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to accept dedication of lands and/or easements from the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
