WHEREAS, the developer, Edgewood, Inc., has received the City of Madison's approval to construct a dormitory and expand the existing parking lot, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Madison is requiring dedication of right-of-way for the installation of a roundabout at a future date.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement For 1014 Edgewood Avenue with Edgewood, Inc.
- 2. That the preliminary concept of a roundabout on Edgewood Avenue at Jefferson Street is hereby approved.
- 3. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents as necessary and accept dedication of lands and/or easements from the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
