Title

Acceptance of the Isman Grant of up to \$5,000 for the Fire Department hazardous materials response team to attend a national conference.

Body

The Fire Department has been awarded the Warren E. Isman Educational Grant . This grant is administered by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Fire Safety Educational Memorial Fund. The \$5,000 award provides funding that will allow the Fire Department to send up to three members of our hazardous materials team to a national hazardous materials response conference. The grant is to cover registration, travel expenses and offset the cost of any needed replacement personnel.
