Commending the Madison Memorial Spartan Boys Swimming and Diving Team on winning the 2009 State WIAA Division 1 Title.

## Body

WHEREAS, the James Madison Memorial High School Spartans Boys Swimming and Diving Team capped off an undefeated 2008-09 season by capturing the school's 10<sup>th</sup> WIAA Division 1 State Title and its fourth state title in five years; and,

WHEREAS, in one of the most competitive battles for team titles in recent memory, the Spartans won as the result of a team effort with points from 10 Spartan swimmers and divers; and,

WHEREAS, Michael Drives had an outstanding individual effort by besting two state records, in the 200-yard and 500-yard freestyle, reclaiming the 200-yard freestyle record for the Spartans in a record-setting time of 1 minute, 38.02 seconds; and,

WHEREAS, in their first year with the Spartans, Coach Paul Eckerle, a former Spartan state champion in his own right, and his assistant coach, Derek Scheer, ably lead the team to the championship; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Madison Common Council recognizes the dedicated support of the parents,

student body and all Spartan fans during the championship season,
