Declaring the City of Madison's intention to exercise its police powers establishing the Capitol Square Streetscape Updates Assessment District - 2010.

Body

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Common Council of the City of Madison hereby establishes an assessment district known as the Capitol Square Streetscape Updates Assessment District 2010 with the following limits:
 - E. Mifflin St. from Wisconsin Ave to N. Pincknev St.
 - N. Pinckney St. from E. Mifflin St. to E. Washington Ave.
 - S. Pinckney St. from E. Washington Ave. to E. Main St.
 - E. Main St. from Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. To S. Pinckney St.
 - W. Main St. from S. Carroll St. to Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.
 - S. Carroll St. from W. Main St. to W. Washington Ave.
 - E. Washington Ave. from S. Pinckney St. to S. Webster St.
 - all in accordance with Section 66.0701 (formerly Section 66.62) of the Wisconsin State Statutes and Section 4.09 of the Madison General Ordinances.
- 2. That the contemplated purposes of this assessment district is to replace sidewalk in the Right-of-Way as needed.
- 3. That the benefited properties shall have the opportunity to pay the special assessments which may be levied as a result of this assessment district in eight (8) annual installments, subject to the current interest rate in effect at the time of establishment of the special assessment.

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- 4. That the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare a report consisting of preliminary or final plans and specifications; an estimate of the entire cost of the proposed work or improvements within the assessment district; a schedule of proposed assessments, constituting an exercise of police power of the City of Madison; and a statement that the property against which the assessments are proposed is benefited.
- 5. That upon completion of this aforesaid report, the City Engineer shall proceed in accordance with Section 4.09 of the Madison General Ordinances.
