The contract terms provide for an annualized salary of \$107,673, effective April 20, 2010. The 2010 adopted operating budget of the Building Inspection Division includes funding for the Director's salary of \$101,336. The difference in funding will be accommodated within the salary budget of the Building Inspection Division. No additional appropriation is required.
