Fiscal Note

This new labor agreement incorporates the wage and benefit provisions currently provided to Library Pages under City ordinances and includes a 3% wage increase in December of 2011 which will result in additional annual costs of approximately \$48,000 beginning in 2012 and an additional 2% increase at the end of 2012 and will result in additional annual costs of approximately \$32,000 beginning in 2013. Funds are available in the 2011 budget to cover current year costs.
