Fiscal Note

The 2011 Adopted Operating Budget contains \$99,440 of funding for the City Assessor position. The new contact calls for an initial annualized salary rate of \$102,248.45. The 2011 funding gap will be covered by the management of salary savings, and the new rate will be included in the 2012 Operating Budget Request. No additional appropriation is necessary at the present time.
