Fiscal Note

The projected cost for the remainder of 2011 is approximately \$270 (or \$384 including fringe benefits). The Police Department expects to be over budget in permanent salaries in 2011. The projected annualized cost is \$2,385 (or \$3,400 including fringe benefits).
