Fiscal Note

Marginal costs for the remainder of 2012 are estimated at \$12,366, or \$17,041 including benefits. Annualized costs are estimated at \$15,000, or \$20,670 including benefits. Funding for the remainder of 2012 is included in the Streets Division Operating Budget, as former Streets Superintendent Al Schumacher was the Public Works Team Leader at the time of budget adoption. It is anticipated that the 2012 year end appropriation resolution will move the required funding from the Streets budget to the Fleet Service budget. No additional appropriation is anticipated at this time.
