Title

To SUSPEND the handcrafted goods, personally prepared food vending restrictions and INVALIDATE certain Mall/Concourse vending licenses from 4:00-11:00p.m. Saturday, August 18, 2012, during WOOF PRIDE and authorizing Woof's as sponsor of the special event, to select vendors, vending sites and performers for the duration of the event on the 100 block of King St.

Body

WHEREAS, Section 9.13 (6) of the Madison General Ordinances and the regulations adopted therein control street vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse area; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.13 (6)(k)1 allows the Common Council to suspend specifically enumerated vending ordinances or regulations and establish alternate rules and procedures during a special event; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.13(6)(k)3. authorizes the Common Council to invalidate street vending licenses, Mall-

Concourse Vending Licenses and sidewalk cafe licenses within the perimeter of a special event in order to encourage the integrity, comprehensiveness and success of a special event; and

WHEREAS, the WOOF PRIDE is such a special event; and

WHEREAS, Woof's, as sponsor of the special event, agrees to obtain a Street Use Permit for the setup and conduct of this event on August 18, 2012 and agrees to comply with the conditions of the permit, including but not limited to any conditions placed on the permit by the Street Use Staff Commission; and

WHEREAS, Woof's, wishes to insure the integrity, comprehensiveness and success of WOOF PRIDE by retaining control over the vending of both goods and food, and has demonstrated that special conditions exist which warrant such action by the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the sponsors agree to comply with all recommendations of the Street Use Staff Commission and the Vending Coordinator concerning the location of vending sites and use of electricity; and

WHEREAS, street vending or Mall/Concourse vending licenses will be invalidated at this location not more than ten times in the year 2012, including this event:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council hereby SUSPENDS the vending restrictions relating to handcrafted goods, personally prepared food set forth in 9.13(6)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances for the streets specifically described above;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council establishes an alternate rule for vending to allow the event sponsor the right to select additional vendors, salespersons and vending sites within the abovedescribed streets from 4:00-11:00p.m. Saturday, August 18, 2012, subject to the conditions of the Street Use Permit for placement of vending sites and equipment

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Common Council hereby INVALIDATES all Mall/Concourse vending licenses within above-described streets and sidewalks from 4:00-11:00p.m. Saturday, August 18, 2012,
