Fiscal Note

The Ordinance codifies existing practice and, as such, is not anticipated to impact General Fund revenues derived from fines and forfeitures.

Title

Amending Section 1.08(3) of the Madison General Ordinances to reduce the bail deposit for expired meter violations.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance reduces the bail deposit for expired meter violations at multispace meters so that it will correspond to the bail deposit for other expired on-street meters under MGO 12.145(1)(a).

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (a) of Subsection (3) entitled "Schedule of Deposits" of Section 1.08 entitled "Issuance of Citations for Violations of Certain Ordinances and Providing a Schedule of Cash Deposits" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended by amending therein the following:

<u>"Offense</u>	<u>Ord. No./Adopted Statute No.**</u>	<u>Deposit</u>
Expired meter - multispace.	12.145(1)(e)	\$2520"

EDITOR'S NOTE: New bail deposits must be approved by the Municipal Judge prior to adoption. This deposit has been so approved.
