There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public Works on Wednesday, June 20, 2012 at 6:30 pm in Room 108 of the City County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

The plan is to open the gates located at the Jerome Street and Bainbridge Street intersections of E. Coldspring Avenue during the remainder of the 2012 Monona Drive reconstruction project and also during the 2013 Monona Drive reconstruction project. The project currently underway is expected to be completed by October 31, 2012. The 2013 project includes Monona Drive from Winnequah Road to Pflaum Road is expected to start March 18, 2013 and run through November 15, 2013.
