Title

Body

WHEREAS, Hickory Hurie has been filling the position of Community Development Division Director on a provisional basis since February 16, 2012; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance allows for provisional appointments for six (6) months unless further approval is granted by the Madison Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the six month provisional appointment is set to expire on August 16, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the position of Community Development Division Director is currently in the final stages of the recruitment process, and

WHEREAS, an extension of the provisional appointment is needed in order to avoid a gap in leadership in the Community Development Division;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Hickory Hurie's appointment be extended on a provisional basis with no change to the terms of his current provisional appointment until the position is filled on a permanent

basis.
