Fiscal Note

The proposed salary of the new Director is \$105,000 annually, plus benefit expense. Sufficient funding for the Director's salary and benefits is included in the 2012 Adopted operating budget of the Community Development Division (CDD). The 2013 Executive operating budget for CDD provides funding of \$100,785 for the Director's salary, plus benefit expense, so CDD will need to absorb the additional total salary and benefit expense of approximately \$5,745 through management of its salary savings.
