PREAMBLE

This project includes coordinating with the developer of the Copps Market to resurface Cottage Grove Rd. between North Star Dr. and McLean Dr., and also includes additional paving as necessary to offset costs of improvements installed by the developer for the City on Cottage Grove Rd. (see contract 2331).

BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for Cottage Grove Road Resurfacing, be and are hereby approved.
- 2) That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project.
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as

necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
