The Booster Station 115 Pipeline Improvements project is located in the Hanson Road Neighborhood Development Plan north of Hayes Road between Portage Road and Interstate 90/94 in part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and also in part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 08 North, Range 10 East, in the City of Madison and the Town of Burke, Dane County, Wisconsin and the authority of the Mayor and City Clerk to sign all documents necessary to accomplish the acquisition of said land interests (17th AD).
