### Fiscal Note

Funding is included in the 2015 adopted Fire Department operating budget. No additional appropriation is required.

### Title

Approving an agreement with Dane County for Hazardous Materials Team Response by the Fire Department.

### Body

The City has an agreement with Dane County for Level B hazardous materials response that expired on December 31, 2014. Dane County wishes to continue to contract for Level B hazardous materials response. The new contract is effective January 1, 2015 and expires on December 31, 2017. The contract also includes a two-year option to renew that is effective January 1, 2018.

The City will receive up to \$49,000 annually for these services. The County will make cash payment of \$39,000 annually for services. The County will also pay the City with purchased equipment of no less than \$8,500 and no more than \$10,000.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to continue a contract with Dane County for hazardous materials response within the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council approve the contract with Dane County for Level B hazardous materials response effective January 1, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council approves the two-year option to extend the contract beyond December 31, 2017.

BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute this agreement.
