In the adopted 2016 capital budget, engineering facilities management has budgeted \$1.05 million for the major project for Park Facilities Improvements (MUNIS 10564) funded from GO borrowing. The minor project for the Esther Beach Restroom improvements (MUNIS 10121) will have sufficient budget authority for the estimated cost estimated in the proposed resolution.

The proposed resolution approves plan documents for the project estimated at a cost of \$425,000 to Engineering Facilities Management.
