Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget, Engineering Bicycle and Pedestrian has budgeted \$2.68 million for the repair of defective sidewalk under the major Sidewalk Program (MUNIS 10148). Funding includes GO borrowing, expense reimbursements, and special assessments. The minor project for the sidewalk repair in District 2 (MUNIS 11104) will have sufficient budget authority to fund the contracted cost. The proposed resolution approves the contract at an amount of \$692,880.00.
