#### **Fiscal Note**

In the 2016 adopted capital budget Engineering Ped/Bike has budgeted \$2.685 million for the major Sidewalk Program (MUNIS 10148) which funds the repair of defective sidewalk. The minor project for 2016 New Sidewalk Installation (MUNIS 11300) has sufficient budget authority for the associated costs of the proposed contract. Funding is provided from GO borrowing and special assessments.

The proposed resolution awards the specified contract for a total estimated cost of \$ 146,170. The split of the cost amongst agencies is as follows:

Engineering Ped/Bike - \$140,720 CDA Redevelopment - \$5,450
