Fiscal Note

The 2016 capital budget includes \$565,000 for Brittingham Park Improvements (MUNIS Project 17159), funded by \$200,000 in GO Borrowing and \$365,000 in impact fees. The budget supports the development of a sidewalk in the park. The estimated cost for the sidewalk project is \$96,000.

Budget authority is available in Acct. No. 17143-51-130.
