Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget the Stormwater Utility has budgeted \$590,000 for the repair and construction of stormwater retention basins (MUNIS 10341). The minor project for Cherokee Pond at Wheeler and Bonner has sufficient budget authority for the estimated cost of the project. Funding for this work is provided by GO borrowing.

The proposed resolution approves the plan documents at an estimated cost of \$340,000.
