Fiscal Note

The 2016 capital budget includes \$1,676,000 for Park Land Improvements (MUNIS Project 17421). The project is funded by \$916,000 in GO Borrowing and \$760,000 in impact fees, donations, and other restricted sources. The proposed resolution will authorize \$41,530 for the Gardner Park Tennis to Pickleball Court Conversion.
