## **Fiscal Note**

In the adopted 2016 capital budget Engineering Major Streets has budgeted \$300,000 for the Neighborhood Traffic Management major program (MUNIS 10546) to retrofit existing streets with structural elements to reduce the speed of traffic. The contract in the proposed resolution provides for the work specified for this project and there is sufficient budget authority available. Funding is provided from GO borrowing.

The proposed resolution awards the specified contract at an estimate cost of \$159,030.
