Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2016 capital budget Engineering-Facilities Management has budgeted \$4.8 million for the continued design and construction of the Madison Municipal Building (MMB) (MUNIS 10550). The project is established with sufficient budget authority for the contract in this proposed resolution. Funding is provided by GO borrowing.

The proposed resolution awards the contract at an estimated cost of \$171,180.
