Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plan documents to receive bids for the Far West Elevated Reservoir project (MUNIS 10445) which will construct a reservoir to ensure adequate supply and fire flow needs. The estimated cost of the work in the proposed resolution is \$3.3 million, which is budgeted in the 2017 Executive Capital Budget. The total amount budgeted in the 2017 Executive Capital Budget for this project is \$4.01 million, and funding is provided by Revenue Bonds.

The proposed resolution approves plan documents at an estimated cost of \$3.3 million.
