Fiscal Note

The 2016 Adopted Capital Budget for the Stormwater Utility approved \$500,000 for the Warner Park Boat Launch Breakwater project, under the major program Shoreline Improvement Program which makes largescale improvements to the public shoreline of lakes, creeks, and rivers. Funding is provided by Stormwater Reserves and GO Borrowing. The 2016 Adopted Capital Budget for the Parks Division includes \$550,000 for improvements to the Warner Park boat launch and breakwater wall under the major program Beach and Shoreline Improvements, funding is provided by GO Borrowing. The respective projects have sufficient budget authority for the work proposed in this resolution.

The proposed resolution approves the contracts for the Warner Boat Launch Breakwater Reconstruction at a cost of \$708,690.
