Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2017 capital budget the Water Utility has budgeted \$4 million for the construction of a water reservoir located on Madison's far west side to reduce pressure on the existing High Point Reservoir (MUNIS 10445). The proposed resolution approves the contract at a total estimated cost of \$2,650,320. Funding is provided by revenue bonds.
