Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2017 capital budget the Engineering Major Streets Division has budgeted \$10 million for the resurfacing of existing streets via their Pavement Management program (MUNIS 10540). The minor project for the resurfacing of the contract in this proposed resolution is established with sufficient budget authority. The proposed resolution awards the contract at an estimate cost of \$1,083,510. Funding is provided by GO Borrowing.
